The Lucie Dutron Macon Villages is a blending of vines in Viré, Péronne and Verzé as the production in each is too small for their own bottlings.

The wine is rich with good intensity. It is round and supple on the palate with good minerality and a long finish.

Grape Varietals: Chardonnay

Vine Age: 20-45 years

Soils: Clay and limestone

Food Pairing: as an aperitif, Shell fish or goat
