



Domaine Houchart is located at the foot of Mount St. Victoire near Aix en Provence. This region is part of the new, elevated appellation “St. Victoire” in Provence.

Domaine Houchart is now owned and run by Florence Quiot and her brother, Winemaker Jean-Baptiste, after the untimely passing of their father Jerome Quiot in 2018.

The 200-acre estate is planted with 10 traditional grape varieties on red-clay, sandstone, gravel and chalk soil. The estate produces 55% rosé, 40% red and 5% white wines.
