Sancerre "Terres Blanches" 2020

Founded in 1955 by a fifth-generation winemaker, Fournier Père et Fils has grown from a four-hectare micro estate to a leader in Sancerre and the Central Loire Valley. Top quality productions from entry level to single vineyard.

The entire team is dedicated to keeping the terroirs in their best possible condition and sustainable methods are key to this effort. They are currently in conversion to HVE3 (High Environmental Value) for their own holdings.

Sancerre may be the most popular but just across the Loire River Pouilly Fume has proven to be a world class terroir for Sauvignon Blanc, Often seen as the better quality vs Sancerre and Fournier is a top Producer in the appellation.

Tasting Note: Tense, mineral, precise... The nose reveals persistent boxwood and blackcurrant bud aromas. The palate is a masterpiece of concentration and length.
