

# CHÂTEAU DE PIZAY

## Beaujolais Blanc 2020

The Château de Pizay is one of the oldest and most famous estates of the Beaujolais region. Since the Middle Ages the fine wines of the Château de Pizay have been appreciated by Beaujolais-lovers across the world. The oldest records date to 1030.

As an appellation, Beaujolais Blanc makes up less than 5% of total Beaujolais production. Estates often tended a reserve vineyard planted with Chardonnay, the product of which adorned the high table.

A rare treasure in the Beaujolais region, of singular grace and charm; Beaujolais Blanc could be seen as the hidden face of the Pizay vineyard, the Château's pearl. So unexpected are its shimmering robe and scents, that any encounter with this wine means love at first sip.



Varietal: 100% Chardonnay  
Vine age: avg 30 years  
Alc %: 12.5

Tasting Note: Soft and graceful with notes of peach and melon. Mild acidity and medium body make it a perfect pairing for more delicate meals.

Sandy granite and silt soils.  
Manual grape-picking. Immediate pressing. Long fermentation of 10 days. Controlled temperature : 16° C.  
Maturing in stainless steel vats to avoid oxidation and keep the young and fresh character. Natural cold stabilization.
