This esteemed estate has been passed on from generation to generation for more than 125 years. Today, Florence Quiot and her brother Jean-Baptiste take a hands-on approach and dedicate themselves to continuing a tradition of the highest quality estate bottled wines.

Their vineyards are spread across 6 appellations of the Southern Rhone valley; and, for all, they take the long view, often waiting years before replanting a parcel to ensure conditions in the soil are perfect for vines to thrive for 100 years or more. Château du Trignon was upgraded to make use of gravity flow, protecting the grapes from damage, and preserving their most delicate characteristics.
