For thirteen generations the Quiot family has been growing vines in Chateauneuf du Pape. For the last few decades, they have used modern techniques to keep traditional style alive. One of just 23 producers who still use all 13 of the original varietals.

Produced by brother-sister team, Jean-Baptiste & Florence Quiot, whose prowess is growing with each vintage soaring to new heights as the ultimate tribute to their twinkle-eyed father Jérôme Quiot, who passed in 2018. An elegant rather than heavyweight style expressing Cinsault and Grenache in particular. The emphasis here is finesse rather than power.

Tasting Notes: "A complex and surprisingly youthful Chateauneuf with savory, minty and peppery notes, as well as damson plums. Impressive tannin structure within the rich body, the lively acidity giving the long, focused finish a lot of drive. Excellent aging potential." -JS
