Ruby-red, bursting with juicy black cherry and plum, as well as violet and lilac notes, this fruity-yet-floral wine maintains classic elegance and authenticity of place while being unapologetically exotic. Sitting in Entre-Deux-Mers, Château L'Orangerie is a family-run estate spanning 350 acres of clay-limestone soil.
