Founded in 1955 by a fifth-generation winemaker, Fournier Père et Fils has grown from a four-hectare micro estate to a leader in Sancerre and the Central Loire Valley. They produce top quality wine from entry level to single vineyard. The entire team is dedicated to keeping the terroirs in their best possible condition with sustainable practices. They are currently in conversion to HVE3 (High Environmental Value) for their own holdings. Sancerre may be famous for their white wine, but the Central Loire was growing Pinot Noir well before Sauvignon Blanc. The vines for this cuvee come from the Touraine area.
