Meaning “Lord of the Manor,” this 100% Malbec from Cahors (considered the birthplace of Malbec) is a nod to the noble families that resided at Lagrèzette for five centuries. Lagrèzette is the oldest winemaking property in Cahors, with harvest records dating to 1503.

Proprietor Alain-Dominique Perrin, former CEO of Cartier, has spent 40-plus years working with renowned oenologist Michel Rolland elevating the Malbec expression to world-class quality. The two studied and cultivated each Lagrèzette parcel uniquely to perfect production. No estate is more synonymous with high-end French Malbec than Château Lagrèzette.
