Quality is of utmost importance and fuels strict limits on vineyard yields, prioritizes hand harvesting and only allows for the selection of the best grapes to build this family-owned, estate-grown classic Chateauneuf-du-Pape Blanc. This is a portfolio darling, opulent and rare. A Milligan crown jewel to be sure.
