

This distinguished Southern Rhône estate has hosted five generations of winemakers over the last 125 years. Today, Florence Quiot and her brother Jean-Baptiste are at the helm and continue the tradition of crafting superior Côtes du Rhône from a patchwork of vineyards that span six appellations of Southern Rhône. The winery sits along the Trignon River that divides Sablet and Gigondas. Access to parcels of the best vineyards from the valley floor to the highest altitudes of the appellation gives rise to wines of rich character and complexity. Savory and spicy, this offering is produced from hillside fruit aged in foudres (large wooden vats). Deep garnet in color, it demonstrates a remarkable depth of terroir revealing pure fruit, silky tannins and a long, supple finish, making Rasteau is a memorable wine.

> Vinification: Total destemming, Vatting time 17 to 21 days, Matured in foudres, or large wooden vats.

Tasting Notes: Fresh and spicy, with smoke, earth and energetic fruit juicy plum, black cherry. Silky tannins with a generous, savory and supple, finish.

Pairing: Juicy prime rib, duck confit, rack of lamb, truffle dishes, hearty stews, and meaty pastas.
