This distinguished Southern Rhone estate has hosted five generations of winemakers over the last 125 years. Today, Florence Quiot and her brother Jean-Baptiste are at the helm and continue the tradition of crafting superior Gigondas. Their vineyards are spread across six appellations of the Southern Rhone Valley; and, for all, they take the long view, often waiting years before replanting a parcel to ensure conditions in the soil are perfect for vines to thrive for 100 years or more. Château du Trignon was upgraded to make use of gravity flow, protecting the grapes from damage, and preserving the delicate characteristics.

Muscat Beaumes-de-Venise its hand harvested very early in the morning as to benefit from freshness.

Pneumatic pressure, cold settling and slow fermentation (18°C) in a stainless steel vat. Grapes must have more than 525 g/L of sugar. 95° grain alcohol is used to halt fermentation at the perfect moment.

Tasting Notes: Lightly spicy and moderately sweet, featuring creamed peach, melon and pear flavors, with a hint of acacia gliding through the finish. - JM. Delicious with: aperitif or as part of a cocktail but also with desserts of fruits, almonds or chestnut.
