A shining star in Burgundy's Côte Chalonnaise, the 140-acre estate was purchased by the Picard family in 1991. Focusing on the Mercurey and Givry AOCs, the diversity of soils has set this Domaine apart for decades. In fact, the estate's wine cellars recently underwent renovations to accommodate the separate vinification of numerous parcels at a time. This block-by-block approach to vinification, blending, aging, and bottling allows Domaine Voarick to capture the specific nuances of terroir and varying soils and subsoils in detail, which is ultimately highlighted in distinct bottle offerings. This organically grown Pinot presents with classic cherry and cocoa notes, silky, elegant and earthy.

Food Pairing: Delicious with juicy grilled steak, roasted lamb with rosemary, or cedar plank salmon.
